## SEWP VI Contract Overview

NASA Solutions for Enterprise-Wide Procurement (SEWP) VI is a Government-Wide Acquisition Contract (GWAC) that federal agencies use to acquire the full range of information technology (IT) products, services, and integrated solutions. The National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) manages the SEWP Program on behalf of the entire Federal Government, and every federal agency and its authorized support contractors place orders through this single vehicle. The contract carries a ten-year period of performance, from November 1, 2026 through October 31, 2036, and a program ceiling of \$20 billion. A fixed administrative fee of 0.34 percent applies to every order with no fee cap, which gives agencies transparent, predictable pricing on projects of any size.

SEWP VI organizes its offerings into categories that align contract holders to the way agencies buy. ESI holds a Category C (Mission-Based Services) award, which positions us to deliver mission-focused IT services that support agency programs from planning through operations and sustainment. As a designated Best-in-Class vehicle, SEWP VI provides pre-competed, fully vetted contract holders and a streamlined ordering process that shortens acquisition lead time. Our federal customers reach ESI's services under terms NASA has already established, and they document fair opportunity with the tools SEWP provides.

As a Category C (Mission-Based Services) Contract Holder, ESI delivers mission-focused IT services, including custom software and application services; cloud and systems integration; cybersecurity and security systems; data, analytics, and digital government; IT engineering and design; network operations and telecommunications; IT management and consulting; and IT training and education. Product-based items are in scope only as ancillary products that are integral to and necessary for a services-based effort; Category C does not cover product-only requirements.
